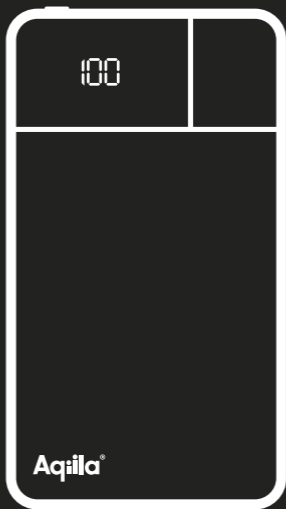

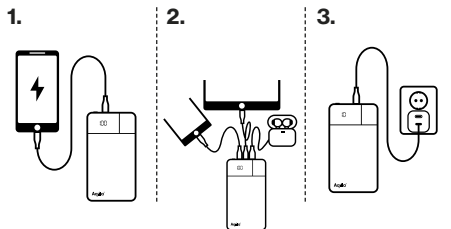
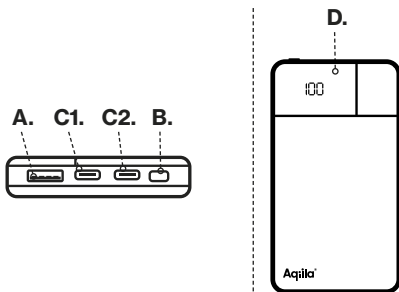

User manual



Know your Powerbird:

- A. USB-A: Charge devices (20W)
- C1. USB-C1: Charge devices (20W)
- C2. USB-C2: Charge devices (20W) & for charging the Powerbird (18W)
- B. Display Button: Turns display on
- D. LCD: Shows battery status 0 - 100 % - Shows green icon when fast charging is activated (only with suitable devices)

How to use your Powerbird:

1. Connect your device to the Powerbird and start charging.
2. Charge up to three devices at the same time. When multiple devices are connected, the maximum charging speed will be shared.
3. Connect USB-C2 to a power source to charge your Powerbird. USB-A and USB-C1 can still be used to charge other devices.

Capacity: 20.000mAh / 74Wh / Lithium-Polymer
 USB-C1 Output: 5V/3A, 9V/2.22A, 12V/1.5A
 USB-C2 Input: 5V/3A, 9V/2A Output: 5V/3A, 9V/2.22A, 12V/1.67A
 USB-A Output: 5V/3A, 9V/2A, 12V/1.5A
 Rated Power: 20W

Charging cable, Carrying strap, Manual

Warnings!
